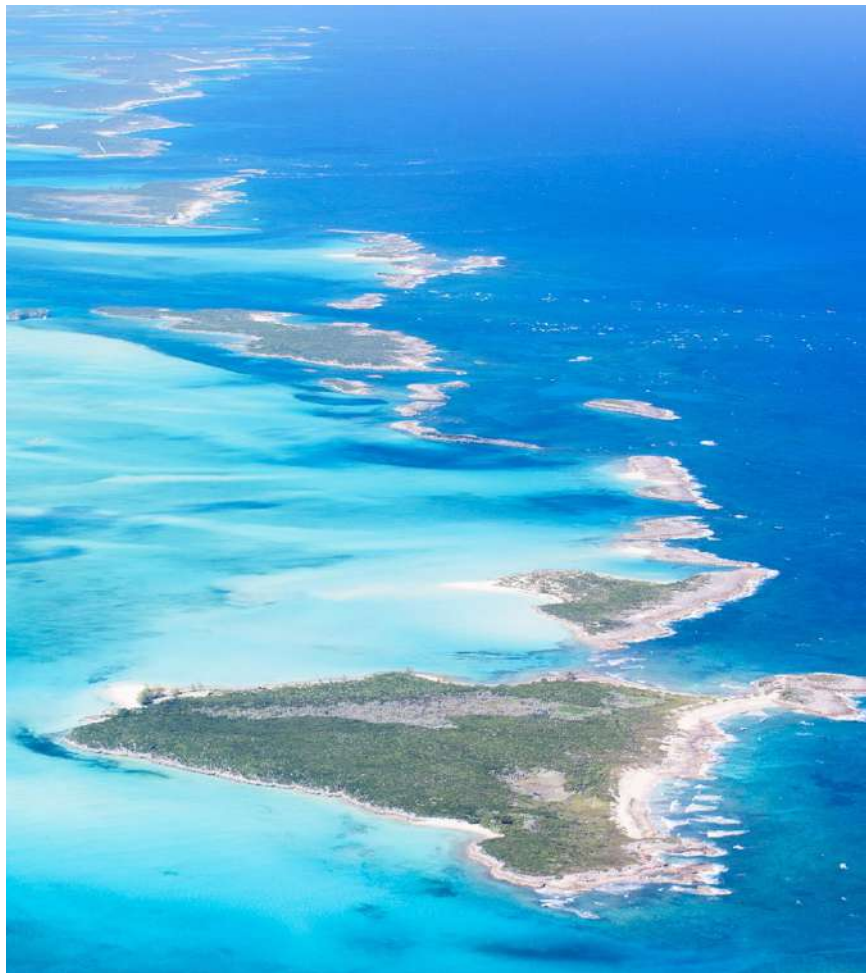

Arriving at the Nassau international airport, you will be taken to the Port Old Fort bay by your private transport service, where your yacht will be awaiting you.

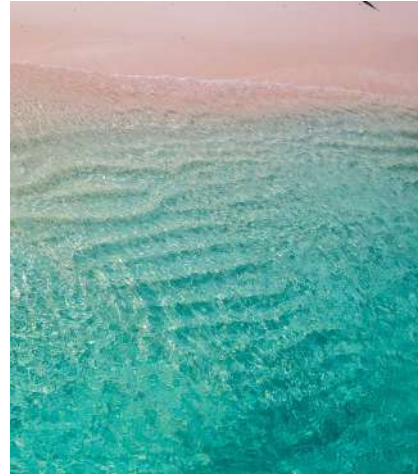


DAY 2

It offers solitude, a stunning five-mile long beach, and a protective reef just offshore teeming with fish and exotic marine life. The island has become a retreat for a number of celebrity visitors, and Savannah Sound has become known for great bonefishing because of its extensive flats and fish-rich waters.





DAY 5

SAVANNAH SOUND - CAT ISLAND

Day 5 you will spend on Cat island, Cat Island has become known cause of their large population of stray cats, which habitants believe brings good fortune and wealth feeding stray cats.

There is a cozy little beach club called Pigeon Cay located on the island. If you like to explore the history of the Islands, don't forget to visit the Hermitage located at the highest point of the Bahamas, it is a small medieval monastery built by a roman catholic priest named father Jerome back in 1939.
